The Central Footwear Training Institute (formerly CFTC), Chennai the premierInstitute of its kind in the country, came into being in July, 1957, with the assistance of Ford Foundation. The erstwhile CFTC was conducting 18 months "Advanced Footwear Technology Course" and Practical oriented need based short - term courses. The CFTC has trained about 6000 candidates, which includes 154 foreign nationals from countries like Nigeria, Mauritius, Philippines, Figi, Tibet, Guyana. Uganda, Zambia Hungary, Srilanka etc.

The Departmentally run Central Footwear Training Centre was converted into an autonomous Institution (Government of India, under the Ministry of Micro Small & Medium Enterprises, Govt. of India) w.e.f. 1.14.1996 for better functional autonomy and was renamed as "Central Footwear Training Institute" Chennai, (CFTI, Chennai). The Institute is modernised with UNDP assistance under the National Leather Development Programme and is fully equipped with state-ofthe art machinery to impart training in the modern methods of Footwear manufacturing

CFTI, Chennai being affiliated with Leather Sector Skill Council (LSSC) is started the pilot phase of Prime Minister Scheme on Skilling India to Make in India.

The National Skill Development Corporation has notified "*Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna* (*PMKVY*)" (*a* Phase II of the STAR Scheme) which aims to skill unemployed youth is the flagship outcome based skill training Scheme of the new Ministry of Skill Development & Enterprenuership (MSDE).

The Objective of the skill certification and reward scheme is to enable and mobilize a large number of Indian youth to take up outcome based skill training and become employable and earn their livelihood.

The training courses of PMKVY is based on the approved QPs (a set of National Occupational Standards) to the Leather Sector in footwear is as follows:

- **Stitchers** for Footwear, Leather Goods and Garments Manufacturing
- **Cutters** for Footwear , Leather Goods and Garments Manufacturing
- Pre Assembly Operator (Splitting, Gimping, Ironing, Marking, Edge coloring, Pasting, Folding & Eyeletting)
- Skiving Operator,
- Lasting Operator,
- Moulding Operator.

Brief Methodology of the implementation of this scheme are

- a. Training will be provided at identified centres by Training partners.
- b. The training duration is for one calendar month
- c. The time slot will be decided by the Industry Employer and Training partner.
- d. The eligibility criteria is minimum 5th standard pass with age limit of about 18 to 35 years preferably with Unique Identification(UID) i.e. Aadhar card .
- e. If the candidates do not possess Aadhar card, the training partner will take the responsibility to get it done.

- f. A Bank Account will be opened for all successful candidates by Training Partner to distribute the cash reward.
- g. All the required data of the students including the UID and bank accounts has to be entered into the SDMS data base.
- h. The training Partner (CFTI, Chennai) have to enter into a MOU with the factories before commencing training.
- The Training Partner (CFTI, Chennai) has to remit the assessment fee (Rs.1200/- per candidate) on behalf of candidate to LSSC immediate after enrolment of the candidates in SDMS Database.
- j. The training partner (CFTI Chennai) will identify the trainers and the Training of Trainers (TOT) will be conducted for adequate competency and standard practices.
- k. Both practical and theoretical classes will be conducted in the ratio of 80 :20. A technical Hand book, Training materials and tools will be provided by Training partner to every candidate.
- I. The Training Partner (CFTI) will depute one trainer and one assistant trainer for giving training to each centre.
- m. A Minimum of 85% attendance at training will be ensured by Assessment Agency.
- n. Training will be provided on Technical skill, Soft skill, Health & Safety.
- Each trainee will be assessed by an Assessing Body and will submit the report to the LSSC. The details of the assessment will be entered into SDMS and forwarded to the LSSC electronically.
- p. The assessment agency in association with LSSC, will award a secure certificate with a QR barcode for successful completion through the SDMS. The certificate will be electronically verified using a CAM device and linked to UID number of the candidate.
- q. The award and issue of the certificates will be captured in SDMS and after successfully meeting all eligible criteria the candidate is eligible for monetary award of about Rs.1875 for the approved training courses at Level 4 against successful completion.

The Training Partner will ensure and assist to have placements for every successful candidate after training. The placement order should be produced by the Industry after having successful training for those who have got employed. Shri. K. Murali, Director, CFTI, Chennai and Shri.
